Primary Forms of Identification:

Driver's License:

. A valid driver's license issued by any state or country is generally accepted.

State-Issued ID Card:

.Similar to a driver's license, these are issued by state agencies for nondrivers.

Passport:

.A valid U.S. or foreign passport is a widely accepted form of ID.

Military ID:

.U.S. military IDs (including those issued to dependents) are generally accepted.

Permanent Resident Card:

.Often referred to as a "Green Card," this is an acceptable form of ID for permanent residents.
