CASS COUNTY BOARD MEETING

June 10, 2024

The Cass County Board met in the Courthouse, in the Courtroom, on Monday, June 10, 2024 at the hour of 6:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Merriman, who directs the Clerk to call roll.

The Clerk calls roll.

Chairman Merriman declares there is a quorum.

Chairman Merriman now leads the board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Merriman presents the minutes of the May 13, 2024, Cass County Board meeting. Hance moves to approve the minutes and Gibson seconds the motion. The vote is by acclamation and declared carried.

Under Correspondence Clerk Wessel reads the thank you letters from Andrew Doellman and Austin Strubbe. Both Deollman and Stubbe were awarded the Cass County Board Citizen Scholarship.

Noe reports the Courthouse and Jail Committee met on June 6, 2024, and approved all bills as presented.

Douglass, Chairman of the Public Safety, Environment and Housing Committee, reports her committee met on May 28, 2024. Roger Lauder gave an ESDA report

Snellgrove reports the Animal Control Commission met on May 29, 2024. There were 11 dogs picked up, 7 were returned to their owners and 4 dogs are still being held in the pound. Jeff Harris resigned effective May 23, 2024. Alex Riviere was appointed to replace Harris. Riviere will start on June 13, 2024. Cory Masters was appointed to a part-time position.

Chairman Merriman reports that Rural Water had a 13.7% loss.

Gibson reports the daycare project in Beardstown is moving right along. They have started putting together a purchase list.

Noe reports that the Housing Authority Office received complaints about people smoking in their apartments.

The Supervisor of Assessments Committee met on May 20, 2024. The quadrennial assessment will be conducted in Ashland, Chandlerville, Newmansville and Panther Creek Townships this year. The next meeting will be held on June 25, 2024.

Douglass reports the Road and Bridge Committee met on June 3, 2024 and approved all bills. Work on Hall bridge is moving forward rapidly.

Noe, reporting for O.E.D.C. reports that Mayor Harris announced the new owner of the old gazette building on wall street plans to renovate the building into apartments.
